The Weekday School has been in operation for over forty years. The school operates as part of the ministries of the church and maintains a supportive partnership with the Children's programs.

SCHOOL YEAR

The FBC Weekday School operates from the Tuesday after Labor Day through the Thursday before Memorial Day. Holidays, Christmas and Spring Break typically follow the Guilford County School's calendar.

OBJECTIVES

1. To provide a pre-school experience that is developmentally appropriate for every child
2. To provide guidance that allows children to develop socially, emotionally, and spiritually
3. To extend the ministries of First Baptist Church to our families

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

1. Faith-based Character Education program
2. Music (weekly for all children)
3. Art daily in classrooms
4. Story Time (2s-5s read to weekly by the Director)
5. Movement (weekly for 3s & 4s)
6. Chapel (monthly for 4s & 5s)
7. Playtime daily on our special playgrounds or in our full-sized gym

SUMMER DAYS

As an extension of the Weekday School, we offer Summer Days. Typically, the camp-like program runs the last week of May and the first two weeks of June. Children attend from 9am - 12 pm daily and enjoy outside play, crafts, art, music and fun activities.

Registration for Summer Days usually begins after Spring Break.

REGISTRATION

Registration begins each year in January. Registration is a three stage process:

- Stage 1: FBC members only
- Stage 2: Non-church members currently enrolled
- Stage 3: Open registration

A registration fee is due at the time of registration each year.

Tuition is charged monthly.
