PrimeTime Bible Study will feature seven of Dr. Steve Pressley's all-time favorite Bible passages...chapters drawn from the Old Testament sections known as Law, Prophets and Writings, plus the New Testament Gospels, the Book of Acts, the letters of Paul, and the General Epistles.

- **October 2** | **Genesis 50:** You meant evil...but God meant it for good (v. 20).
- **November 6** | **2 Chronicles 20:** Stand firm, hold your position...do not be afraid and do not be dismayed (v. 17).
- **December 4** | **Isaiah 40:** They who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength;...(v. 31).
- **February 5** | **Matthew 19:** With man [salvation] is impossible, but with God all things are possible (v. 26).
- **March 5** | **Acts 20:** I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself (v. 24).
- **April 9** | **1 Corinthians 1:** God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong;...so that no human being might boast (vv. 27-29).
- **May 7** | **2 Peter 3:** But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells (v. 13).
